


St Kevin's Goal is \$21,198 Nuestra Meta


REFLEXION DEL EVANGELIO DE HOY

La Pascua es la celebración de la Resurrección de Cristo de entre los muertos, que culmina con su Ascensión al Padre y el envío del Espíritu Santo sobre la Iglesia. Se celebra el domingo, y marca el final de la Semana Santa y el fin del Sagrado Triduo Pascual (Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Vigilia Pascual), y es el inicio del Tiempo Pascual del año litúrgico.

La Pascua se caracteriza, sobre todo, por la alegría de la vida glorificada y la victoria sobre la muerte, expresada del modo más pleno en el gran grito resonante del cristiano: ¡Aleluya! Toda fe fluye de la fe en la resurrección.

TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLEXION

Easter is the celebration of Christ's Resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. It is celebrated on Sunday, and marks the end of Holy Week and the end of the Sacred Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil), and is the beginning of the Easter Season of the liturgical year.



Easter is characterized, above all, by the joy of glorified life and the victory over death, expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian: Alleluia! All faith flows from faith in the resurrection

Divine Mercy Abril 7, 2024



