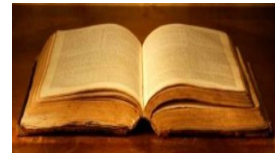

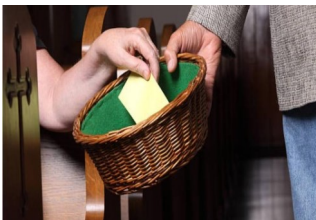

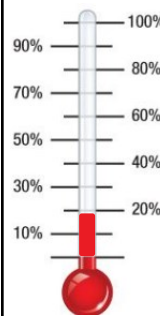

What are The Scrutinies?

This ancient rite of the Catechumenate for Adults, comprising several distinct steps toward a person's new life of grace by Baptism, was restored by Pope Paul VI. The period of the catechumenate, which is intended as a time to learn and live out the Christian faith, is sanctified by sacred rites to be celebrated at successive intervals. It is important that these rites be celebrated among the entire parish community as we come together to accept and encourage our new brothers and sisters into our ecclesial family. At St Kevin we will have the 2nd scrutiny during 9:30am please add the group of elected to your prayers.
