
NO BAD NEWS

There are many times when we say, "Tell me what I want to hear, and don't confuse me with facts." And we don't take kindly to someone who might be bold enough to snuff out our expectations.

The biggest problem with such an attitude is not that we miss out on the truth or the facts, but that we miss out on the new and surprising gifts others can give us. Like the townspeople in today's Gospel story, we too often refuse to allow others to display the talents that can be good news for us.

Today's readings call for hospitality and faith and discernment. Hospitality opens the doors of our hearts and minds to the "stranger" among us, no matter how familiar he or she may seem to be. Faith enables us to accept the gifts of others, no matter how alarming or "strange" they may seem to be. Discernment helps us discover the prophets in our midst, no matter how amazing they may seem to be. Hospitality, faith, and discernment—cultivate these. Then, nobody can bring bad news.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

The Lord, as always, in His plans, has surprised us all. To you, with the change of pastor and to me with the charge of guiding, caring for and nourishing this community of St. Kevin. Together, we will make a journey of faith, knowing that God in His infinite mercy has intertwined our lives.

There are many challenges at hand moving forward in this post-pandemic climate. We face the challenge of being good collaborators in His work, deepening our relationship with Him and helping our brothers and sisters to have an intimate and personal encounter with Him, who is the only one who can transform our lives and fill them with meaning.

We have the great challenge of making our community a house with open doors for all, providing healing spaces that are warm and welcoming, without exclusions. This will be a clear witness and proclamation of the faith that we profess and celebrate in each Eucharist. I am here, with all my littleness, offering myself to the Lord in this service to which He calls me to be your pastor. I invite you all to undertake this adventure with me of being companions on the road, family and community.

As my compatriot Pope Francis would say: "Pray for me for I will pray for you", keeping you present in each Eucharist.
